What's New?

Microsoft has rolled out a few new tools to our Government Community Cloud (GCC). If you have completed the O365 Phase II rollout, "Microsoft Lists" is one of those new tools. The Lists app is accessible through Office on the Web. The Lists app helps track information and organize work. The app, which can be used within Teams, provides customizable views, rules, and alerts to keep you and everyone on the Team in sync. "Lists" training is available on our Learning Pathways site.





"Microsoft To-Do" is a personal task management app that empowers users to track and focus on the things they need to get done. To-Do web app is available to all Office365 users and can be accessed at to-do.office.com. On the Learning Pathways website, you will find new training videos on To-Do. (Note: To-Do Windows 10 and mobile apps are not yet available in GCC.)

Lists, To-Do, Tasks, Planner; so many tools, which should I use? In this you tube video (from Jumpto365, hosted by Matt Wade), Matt compares Planner, Lists, To-Do, and Tasks in Teams. Although the Tasks app in Teams is not yet available in the GCC environment, the comparisons may help you determine which tool is best for your specific need!

(Note: The web offers a wealth of tutorials and information, however, understand that what you find on the web does not always apply or may not yet be available in the GCC environment.)
