



SHIFTS IN MS TEAMS Now Available

All Aboard MS Teams! Goodbye Skype for Business (SfB).

Now that most of us are on board with using Teams for chat and meetings, it is time to retire the Skype for Business (SfB) application. The SfB Retirement Project kick-off meeting was held on June 29th. The project is slated for completion by the end of the year 2021.

The project has 3 key milestone dates:

August 16 - No new SfB accounts created and no longer enabling SfB conference dial-in feature for existing users.

September 27 - Department of Technology and Information (DTI) staff move to "Teams Only Mode." (Originally 9/20)

We understand that change takes time; we highly suggest you attend MS Teams training sessions, ramp up your use of MS Teams and become more comfortable with it. We encourage you to begin using MS Teams exclusively and begin a review of any scheduled or recurring SfB meetings that can be rescheduled as Teams meetings.




