Perhaps you have started your meeting and realized you forgot to


include someone. You can quickly send them a chat with your Meeting ID and Passcode. They can open their calendar in Teams and click on the button in

the top right-hand corner, # Join with an ID.

Have you noticed the latest new features that Microsoft has added to the Outlook App and Outlook on the web?


Share an email to Teams from Outlook:

- Quickly open a Chat session directly from Outlook and chat with the sender or all email recipients.
- Quickly establish a meeting with all email recipients.

When you receive an email message that may be answered with a short reply, Outlook suggests three responses that you can easily click on for a quick reply. Suggested replies are generated by a computer algorithm and use natural language processing and machine learning technologies to provide response options.
