

Teams Recordings: 120-Day Expiration



The 120-day expiration was chosen because, on average, 99% of recordings are never watched again after 60 days, and recordings take up a lot of storage space. On average, 7MB of storage is consumed per minute of a recorded Teams meeting.

#### 120-Day Expiration on New Teams Meeting Recordings

On the evening of October 13, 2023, a new Microsoft (MS) Teams policy will be implemented for Teams Meeting recordings. Newly created MS Teams recordings will automatically expire 120 days after they are recorded if no action is taken. The expiration policy will only apply to recordings made after implementation of the policy; Teams recordings made before will remain unaffected.

Teams meeting recordings (see example to the right) lets you know that the auto-expiration feature is enabled. It is also important to note that the recording owner can override the Teams recording expiration date for each recording.

When a recording expires, it is moved to the recycle bin, and the owner will receive an email notification to take action if needed. The owner can retrieve the expired recording from the recycle bin for up to 90 days. Learn how to restore a deleted file HERE.

**IMPORTANT:** This new feature will not impact recordings created before the 120-day expiration is implemented on October 13, 2023.

Egress Banner Update. Color schemes can allow users to be able to see information more clearly. While this is important for designing a product or tool for any audience, it is vital for audiences with low vision. It was brought to our attention by our Digital Accessibility Manager that the Egress banner would be more accessible if the color schema were updated. On October 13, 2023, the Egress background color will change from orange to blue.




Pictured below: Egress New Look with Blue background with White text
