

The New Microsoft (MS) Teams App (Windows and Mac):

Starting April 1, 2024, MS Teams app will be automatically updated to new Teams. You can opt to update your Teams now by manually selecting the toggle in the upper left corner of Teams. Updating your app will not significantly impact your user experience, but it will provide you with a more flexible app that is up to two times faster.



If you encounter issues with the new Teams, you should report it to the DTI Service Desk, and toggle back to the classic Teams from your Teams setting menu.

Bookings with Me:

Are you familiar with apps that allow people to book a meeting with others? Bookings with Me is a web-based scheduling page that can be set up to allow both external or internal individuals to book appointments or meetings with you. Scheduling Poll helps minimize the back-and-forth emails in scheduling by letting you send a poll to attendees inside and outside of your organization so they can vote on which meeting times work best for them (available to all in January 2024).
