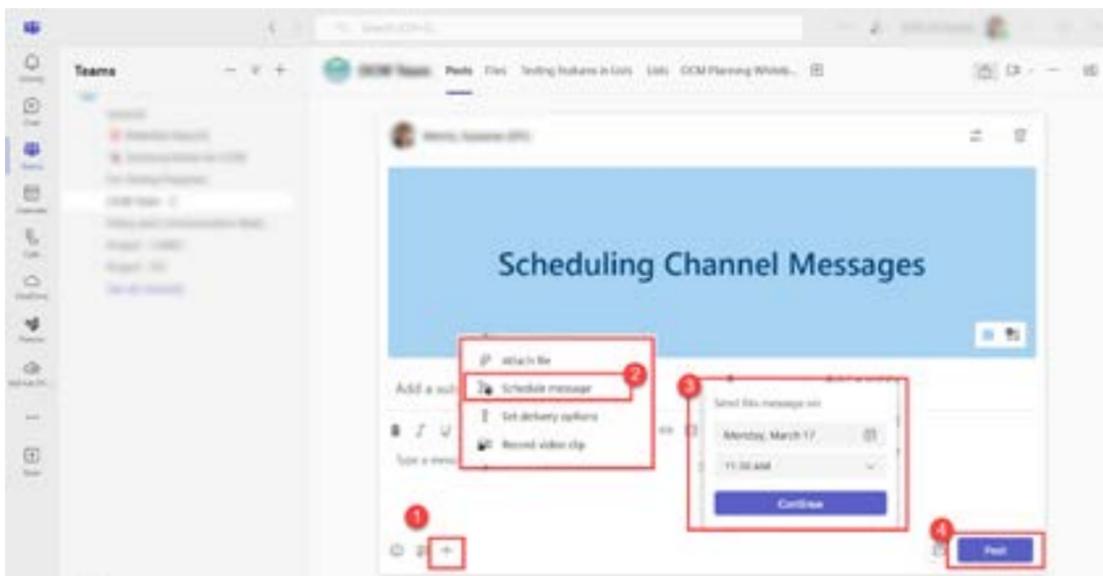

Microsoft Teams: Scheduling Channel Messages

This new feature enables you to schedule messages to be posted in a Microsoft Teams Channel at a specific date and time. This helps you plan and manage your communications more effectively. While this feature has already been available in Chat, it is now also available in Channels.

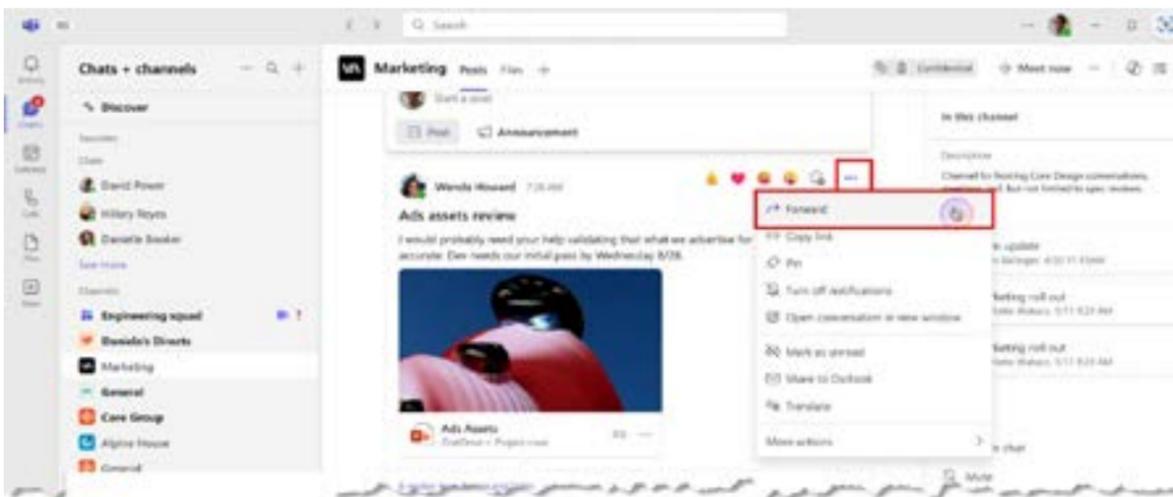
To schedule a message in the Teams Channel, click  , then...

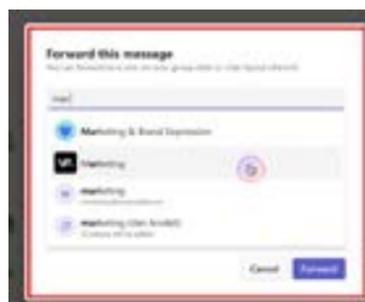
Microsoft Teams: Forwarding Messages To & From Channels

To forward a channel message, select the three-dot More actions menu on any channel post or reply message and then choose Forward.



In the *Forward this message* dialog box, users can select any destination chat or channel. Including channels in the people picker is a new addition to the forward message dialog on desktop.

Microsoft Teams: Forwarding Loop Components

We talked about Loop Components in the [3rd Quarter 2024 Bulletin](#). Now you have the ability to forward loop components in Microsoft Teams. With the addition of loop component forwarding, users have a new way to share loop components across chats and channels. To forward a message containing a loop component, simply navigate to the more actions menu of any message containing a loop component and select forward. From there, the forward this message dialog will populate, which provides users with a preview of the message being forwarded, including the loop component. Users will be able to give permissions to recipients of the loop component to ensure all recipients have access to the content.
