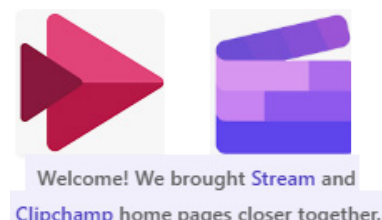

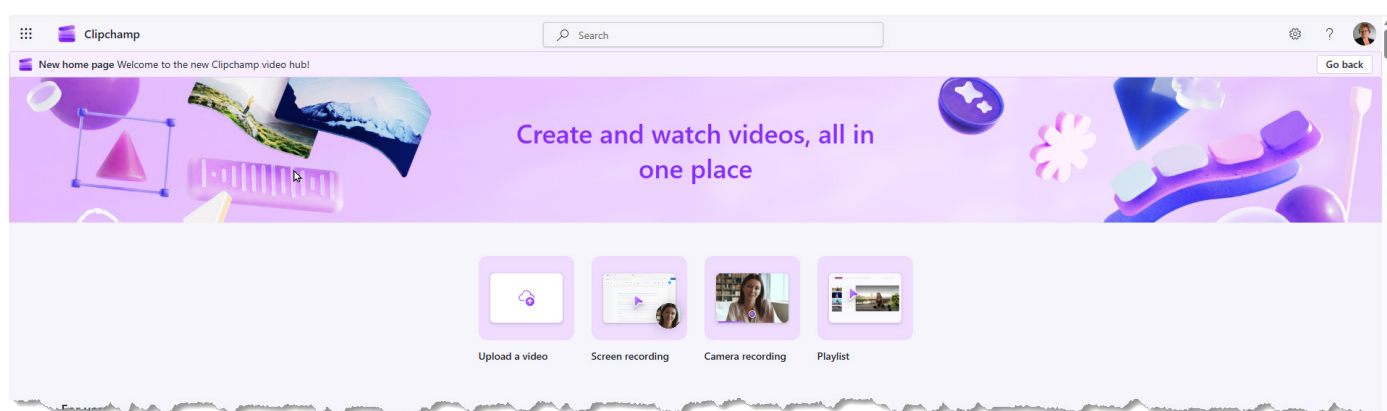
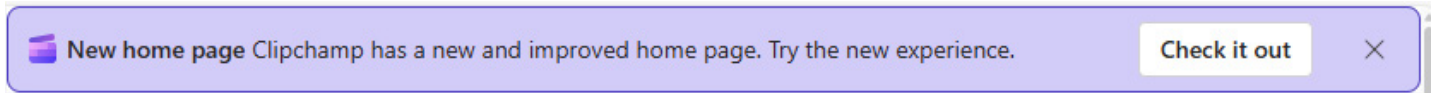

## Microsoft Stream: Now Rebranded as Clipchamp

Microsoft has merged Stream and Clipchamp to create a seamless video experience. You may have already noticed that the Stream icon in your Teams menu bar has been rebranded to reflect the Clipchamp icon. When you launch the Stream app you will see its start page has been updated to the **Clipchamp Video Hub**. These changes are part of Microsoft's ongoing efforts to unify video experiences across Microsoft 365.



It is important to note that the full Clipchamp video editor features are not yet available in our Government Cloud Community (GCC); however, videos you previously accessed through Stream will now appear in the new Clipchamp Video Hub interface, and you can still do screen and camera recordings.



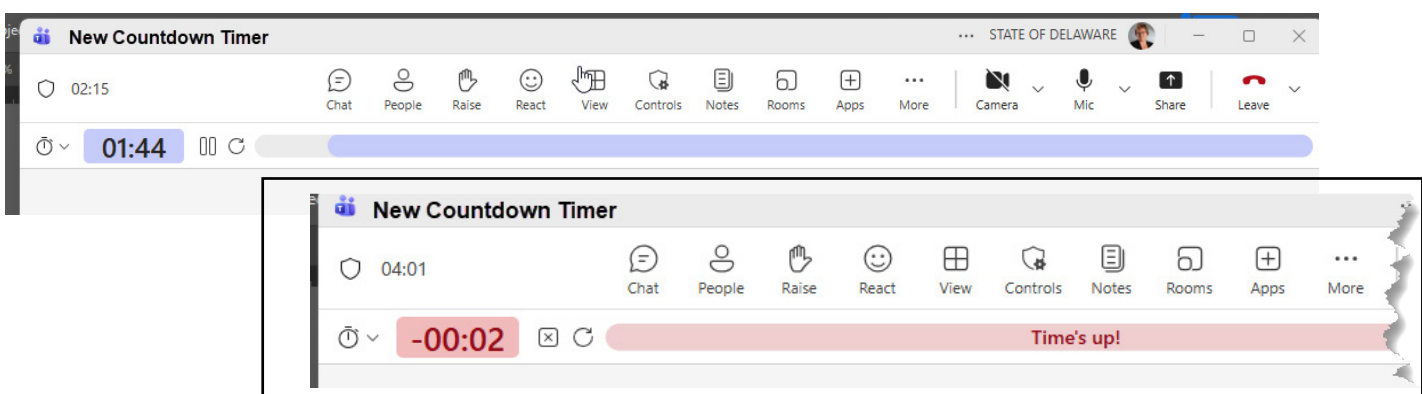
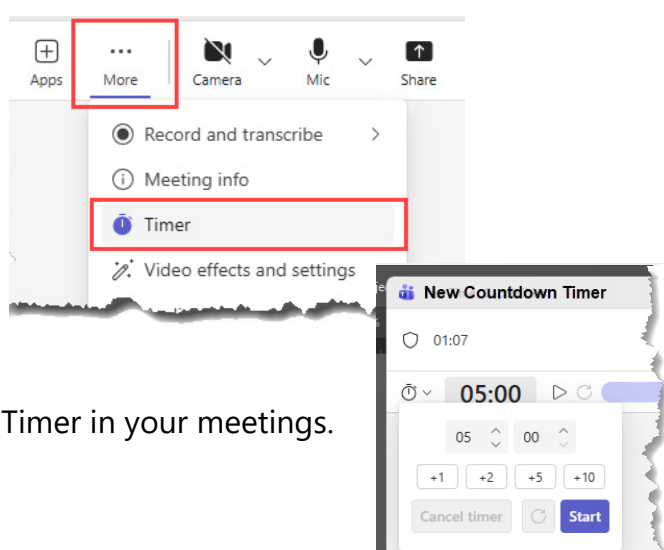
## Microsoft Teams: Countdown Timer

You may have already noticed the new countdown timer available in your **Microsoft Teams Meetings**. The feature is accessible to all meeting participants and can be set for up to 100 minutes. It can assist in keeping meetings efficient and on schedule. Once the timer runs out, it begins counting negatively to encourage timely wrap-up of the meeting.

## Microsoft Teams on the Web: Accurate Presence

In December, Microsoft will introduce a new user-enabled setting in **Teams on the Web** that will help to maintain your presence more accurately. When enabled, Teams will detect activity on the device even when not actively using the Teams tab, thus ensuring your status remains "Available." Teams will only detect whether you are active or idle, it does not track specific actions or content.

This feature is off by default and must be enabled by the user. To enable the setting:

- Once logged onto **Teams on the Web**, select the **ellipses (...)**, navigate to the **Settings** menu, select **Notifications and activity**, scroll to the section labeled **Presence**.
- Toggle ON the option **"Keep my current status when I'm active outside of Teams on the web."**
- The browser will prompt users to grant permission for Teams to detect activity.
